## **Austin Seven body types**

The following table contains data extracted from various published sources but we offer particularly grateful acknowledgement to the A7CA and DA7C websites. The Table aims to provide a brief summary of Austin Seven body type codes that readers might find useful. A very interesting and highly detailed chronological schedule of nearly all A7 changes can be found in the 750 Club's 'Companion' publication from page 46.

Please note that although the starting date for each model is given - the change over was often gradual whilst Austin used up old stock during the early production of each new model.
